Capacity: 10 children

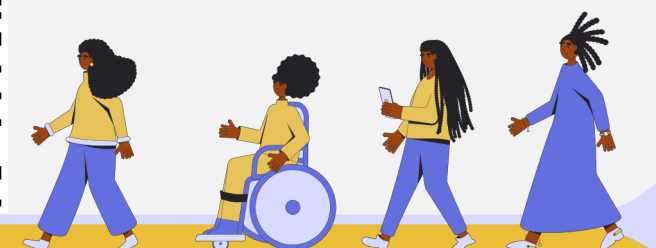
Venue: Minato International Association (Aoyama 1-chome)
